Chairman Dudley called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

There was no Public Comment.

Selectmen Corey made the motion to approve minutes from Easton Board of Selectmen 10 February 2014 Regular Meeting and 26 February 2014 Special Meeting. Selectmen Blackstone seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Selectmen Allen made the motion to approve and sign Treasurer's warrants #123-#126 and #1-#10. Selectmen Blackstone seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Selectmen Flewelling made the motion to approve and sign abatement for Joel and Lori Michaud. Selectmen Corey seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Selectmen Flewelling made the motion to change the health insurance policy to reflect all new hires after 10 March 2014 will be provided 100% for the individual and 50% of the dependents health insurance coverage. Selectmen Blackstone seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-2.

Selectmen Blackstone made the motion to offer all new employees hired after 10 March 2014 \$5,000 in lieu of taking health insurance. Selectmen Allen second the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Selectmen Corey made the motion to authorize the Town Manager to hire two highway workers making the total number of full time highway employees to three. Selectmen Allen seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Easton Board of Selectmen reviewed the 2013-2014 Financial Audit. So noted.

Easton Board of Selectmen reviewed the Superintendent of Schools annual letter for the town report. So noted.

Easton Board of Selectmen reviewed the letter from Aroostook Municipal Association concerning a meeting to be held in Island Falls. So noted.

Selectman Allen made the motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 pm. Selectman Corey seconded motion. Motion carried 5-0.
