Registration Information

- Registration & release forms are included in this booklet; return them at your first convenience to the school or the Town Office. Some programs are right around the corner, so time is of the essence. Both release forms must be on file for ALL participants.
- Payments should be made for all programs at the time of registration. Some programs have a maximum number of participants. A child will not be considered enrolled in a program until payment is made in full unless other arrangements have been made.
- Please make checks payable to the Town of Easton.

Program Times

- It is essential parents know the time programs begin & end so arrangements are made to have the child picked up on schedule.
- Due to our small staff and the many programs offered, there is often little or no time between activities. Please do your very best to have your child dropped off & picked up on time!
- Children should not be dropped off early; it leaves the Town at risk of liability and your child could be unsafe. Thanks for your cooperation.
- We do our absolute best to adhere to bus schedules; however, road work, sick children, etc. are out of our control. If we are running more than 15 minutes late, you will be contacted.

Discipline

If your child misbehaves or is not listening to our staff or parent volunteers while participating in any program, the following actions will be taken:

1st Warning - Verbal warning & director/staff will be notified.

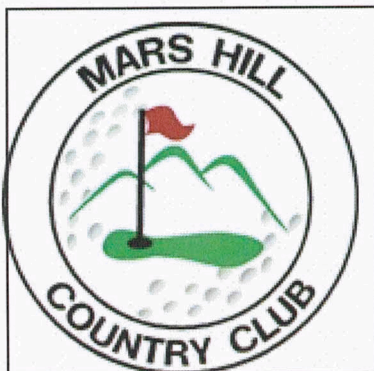
2nd Warning - Child will be removed from activity for the remainder of the day.

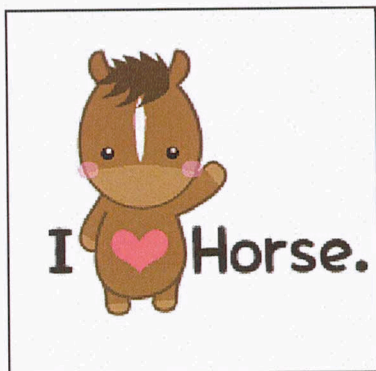

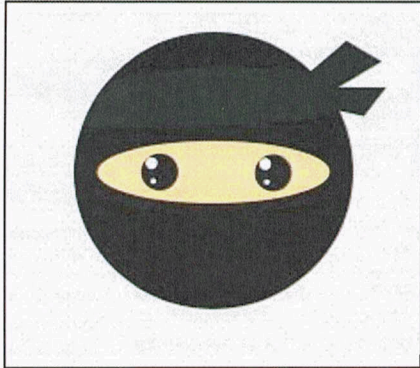

Friday, October 2nd- Leaf Art

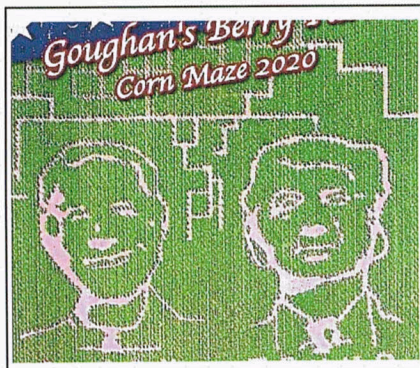
