Chairman Dudley open the public hearing for approval of General Assistance Ordinance A-D for 2015-2016 years. Hearing no public comment public hearing was closed.

Selectmen Blackstone asked about the value of the siding at the Station Road railroad tracks and to whom it belonged. Manager Gardner stated he would consult with the assessing agent and get back to Selectmen Blackstone.
