Recreation

Easton's recreational activities are virtually unlimited. The Town boasts excellent year-round recreation programs for children through senior citizens. The Easton Recreation Department involves the community as a whole in many organized events such as Winter Carnival and Easton Field Days which is a week-long event ending with a parade and fireworks.

Easton is home to spectacular ATV and snowmobiling trails providing direct access to the Interconnected Trail System (ITS) with trails connecting Mars Hill, Fort Fairfield, and Presque Isle, as well as trails that connect you with the Canadian border's scenic vistas overlooking Aroostook County and Canada.



School System

A district enrollment of approximately 250 students provides for small class sizes, which creates a quality educational experience for students. Business & Industry

The hard-working small town pride can be seen in the farming industry as well as in a number of locally owned and operated businesses in Easton. There is a unique blend of businesses including: contractors, grocery, antiques, gas station, fresh locally grown produce stands, and Amish markets. Just a short commute brings you to a major hospital, shopping mall and other retail stores, two colleges, and the Northern Maine Regional Airport.

Along with a strong work ethic, the natural resources are the foundation of Easton's economy. Huber Engineered Woods LLC (HEW) and McCain Foods, INC. are two of the major contributors to the continuing economic stability in Easton.

Huber Engineered Woods LLC (HEW), acquired by Huber in 1981 and made operational in 1983, made Easton its home and now employs more than 112 people. Huber is responsible for such innovative building products as AdvanTech® Flooring and Sheathing and ZIP System® Roof and Wall Sheathing. HEW also takes an active role in the community supporting Project Graduation and providing two annual \$500 academic scholarships.

McCain Foods acquired the Easton plant in 1976. Currently one of the largest frozen potato operations on the east coast, they employ approximately 550 people. The specialty products include: French Fries, Tatter Tots, Patties, Hash Browns, Curly Fries, and Waffle Fries including battered and non-batter products. Easton McCain Foods provides its employees with a family-oriented, challenging, and rewarding work environment to thrive in. They contribute in many local community events and support state and national charities.
