Spring Vacation Activities

Tuesday, April 17 -

Wednesday, April 18 - Field trip to the Caribou Rec for an inflatable morning with area rec. departments. The bus will depart from the Hall at 9:15 and return around 12. The cost is \$3. Concessions will be available.
